We offer the Citizens' Gallery to rent with a fee, as a space for the display of the public's work. This venue for the exhibition of arts – such as painting, sculpture, calligraphy, crafts, and video – is accessible to individuals, groups, and organizations, regardless of whether you reside in or outside of Meguro.

■ Periods/Times of Availability

In principle, we lend the space in one-week units, excepting holidays.
Time of use for one day is from 10 am to 6 pm, which includes loading in, exhibition, and loading out time.

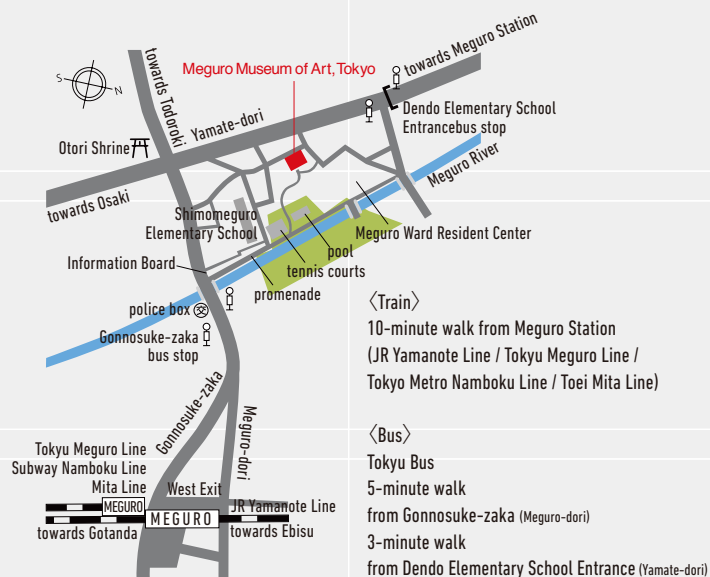
■ Application for Use

Léonard Foujita Private on Works

To commemorate the 50 years since the death, we introduce the painter Léonard Tsuguharu Foujita's work on a great number of illustrated books he produced throughout his lifetime. Centering on his "Book Work", including books published in France before the WWII, his work in Japan during the 1930s and 40s, and illustrations of Edition de Luxe after immigrating to France in 1950, we will display paintings and prints, postcards and illustrated letters to friends, handmade toys and pottery, introducing Foujita's wide range of creative activities.

Power of Ceramics : Modernism in Finnish Applied Arts

Ceramic Art in Finland flourished most in 1950–1960 period as the "fine art". In this era, known as the "Golden Age", the expression through Finland's original ceramics, which clearly differentiated from the modern design of Scandinavia, turned out creations one after another. In this exhibition, we will methodically introduce Finnish ceramics in Japan for the first time, focusing on works from artists in affiliation with Arabia, Finland's representative ceramics company.

Murakami Tomoharu, who lives in Meguro, is a most acclaimed Japanese artist in the international contemporary art scene today, and has been attracting much attention lately. Murakami has consistently employed black paint and pencil to express his original world. From the tranquil and dignified monochrome surface, one can feel everlasting time ticking away in the act of drawing. We introduce Murakami's deep spiritual world, which can be likened to prayer.

This year, with the exhibitions we've held so far as a start, we will also introduce the works and materials that have been newly added to our Collection, triggered by the exhibitions of the past.

Educational Activities

■ Meguro City Complex Guided Architecture Tour (April – June, 4 times)

Guided tour of Meguro City Complex by docents of professional architects (formerly Chiyoda Life Headquarters, 1966), designed by Togo Murano.

■ "Playing With Natural Motifs" Workshop (July – September)

In tandem with the "Ceramic Art of Finland" exhibition in summer, this workshop works around the themes of animals and plants.

■ "Seeing & Learning About Art IV" Workshop (February – March)

We run courses such as "Journey to Classical Technique", which reconsiders the fundamentals of art and focuses on technical materials.

■ Outreach "Toy Collection of MMAT", "Toi-no-Hi"

A program for parents and children to play dynamically with building blocks and puzzles, with excellent designs from the toy collection of MMAT.

■ Art Café for Adults

Curators in charge of each exhibition speak around engaging stories, such as episodes from preparing exhibitions and so on, in a casual atmosphere.

■ Art Course 1 (Director's Talk)

The director of the museum gives a series of talks.

■ Art Course 2

Talks about specific themes.

■ Gallery Tour for children

We welcome art appreciation groups through classes from schools inside and outside Meguro.

We run a workshop on design, in collaboration with Herman Miller Japan, Inc.

○ Meguro Autumn Art
