

English-language Guided Architectural Tour Meguro City Office Building Complex 2026

The Complex designed by Togo Murano in 1966

The Meguro City Office building complex was originally built as headquarters of Chiyoda Insurance Company in 1966 and was converted into a city office building with minimal renovations in 2003. It was designed by the renowned Japanese architect Togo Murano (1891–1984), and is considered as one of his major works. The Meguro Museum of Art, Tokyo (MMAT) has been organizing Japanese-language architecture tours of the complex since 2004. The tour is held four times a year and attracts many participants each year. The tour explores various points throughout the building where the Murano style is distinct and the skillful craftsmanship of the time is well preserved. It shares the excitement of studying this rare surviving example of the architect's work.
